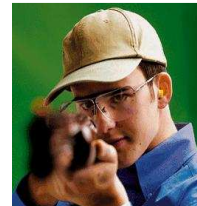

 using **Gunfit** and an Adjustable Stock

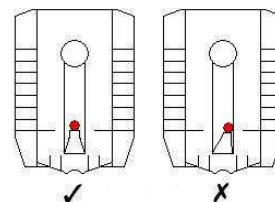
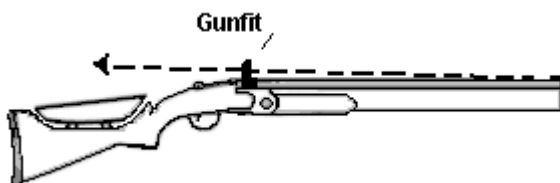

**Finding the Correct Cast**

**STEP ONE**

Use Gunfit to set the cast on your gun as shown in the diagram below.  
 Set your gun's cast with the adjustable stock in the low position.

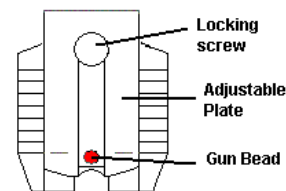
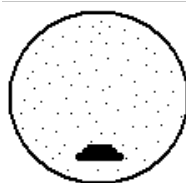
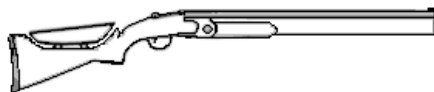


Now lock the stock's cast in this position.

**Finding the Correct Height**

**STEP TWO**

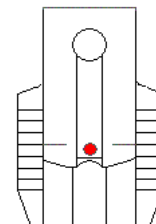
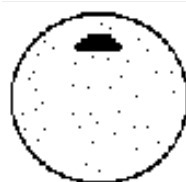
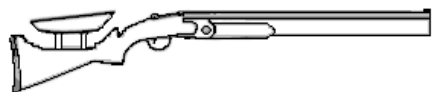
Start shooting, raising the adjustable stock until you are getting good breaks.



You can be getting good breaks but not in the centre of the pattern.  
 Take this measurement using the Gunfit.

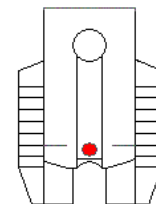
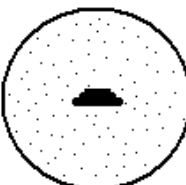
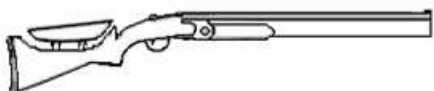
**STEP THREE**

Start shooting, lowering the adjustable stock until you are getting good breaks.



Again you may be getting good breaks but not in the centre of the pattern.  
 Take this new measurement with Gunfit.

**STEP FOUR**



Find the point half way between the two measurements on the Gunfit.  
 This should be the correct height of stock that you shoot for tran disciplines.

These measurements can be transferred, used for 'dry' mounting or making a new purchase. Remember - Do not shoot with Gunfit in position.
